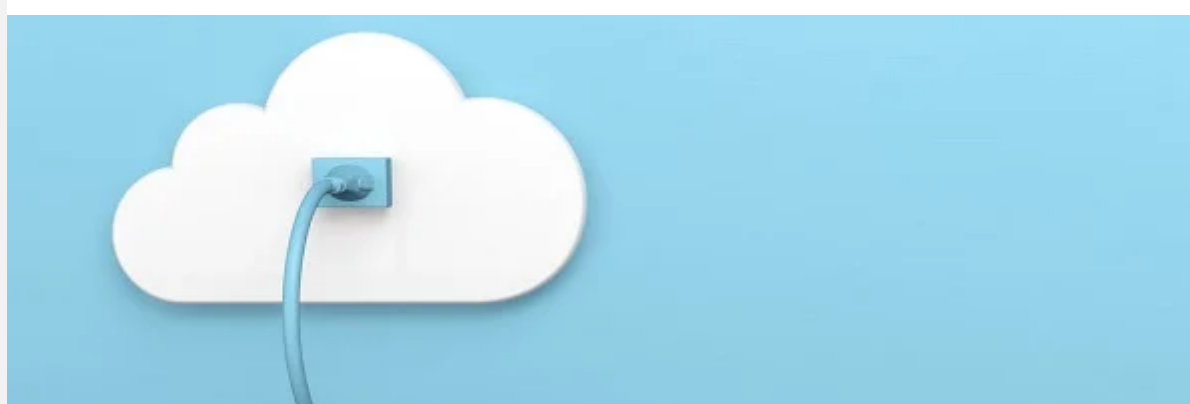

Cloud Automation Integrations for Azure

For about as long as there's been what we've known as "the cloud," there's been Microsoft Azure. The technology was first unveiled in 2008, and the number and nature of the offerings available have continued to evolve. Today, the Azure cloud platform features 200 products and services, including virtual computing, storage, networking, and analytics offerings.

In Azure environments, teams can employ basic, time-based schedulers. However, these technologies can't intelligently accommodate dependencies—and these workflows typically have multiple upstream and downstream dependencies. The only option is to create hard-wired time delays, that is, scheduling subsequent tasks to start at a time after which prior tasks are expected to have been completed.

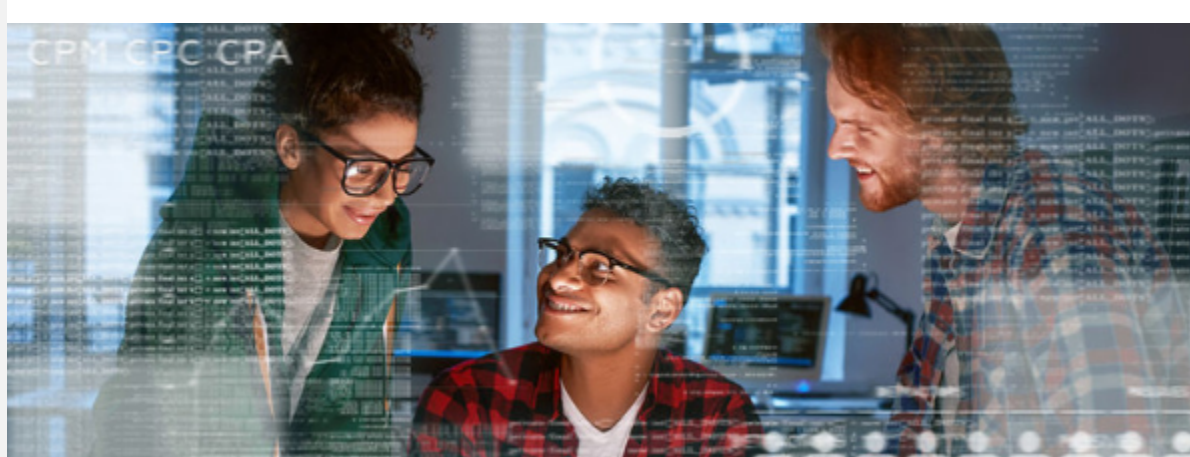
